VISITOR ACCESS PASSES:

✓ Trainees may invite 4 guests (18 and older) that require installation access

- Children under 18 may accompany parents/guardians and do NOT require a separate pass
- Trainees will work with their guests to get visitor pass information
- Visitor passes will be mailed directly to the guests on/around the third week of training
- Passes and proper IDs must be shown to enter the installation

DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE ID CARD HOLDERS:

 \checkmark Any individual with installation access may attend the ceremony

Department of Defense ID card holders may escort individuals onto the installation as long as all parties are in the same vehicle.

- Escorts are authorized to escort up to 5 visitors at any one time onto any Joint Base San Antonio location.
- Escorts must physically escort their visitors and remain within reasonable visual contact with the visitor throughout the visitors' stay on the installation.
- The accepted vehicle ratio is one escort for one vehicle of visitors.
- Escorts of visitors are responsible and liable for the actions of their visitors while on the installation.
- Escorts must report any conduct by the visitor that is deemed suspicious, detrimental to the safety and order of the JBSA community. The 802d Security Forces Squadron, Base Defense Operations Center will be notified immediately of any incident that risks the safety and welfare of the JBSA community.
